



On June 14, we have scheduled a visit to the **OSBORNE** Winery, in Puerto de Santa María, a city located at the bottom of the Bay of Cádiz. We can move there in half an hour, either by bus, or by catamaran, since the station is 200 meters from the winery.

First we would visit the winery in English (1 hour approx.) and then they would offer us a tasting of their wines in the tasting room.



The art of "Venenciar" comes from the expression "the cup of compromise (avenencia)", which was used when deals were closed, they shook hands and offered a glass of sherry.

"Venenciar" is a complex skill that requires a good pulse and a lot of sensitivity.

Since 1772, year in which Tomas Osborne Mann founded Osborne in El Puerto de Santa María, Osborne has preserved the largest collection of old wines from Jerez.

Bodegas with solera, carefully tended gardens, centennial buildings in a unique enclave.

Wine and Brandy de Jerez, aged according to the traditional method of "soleras y criaderas", become a world-renowned oenological pleasure.

Bodegas Osborne is the cradle of the Osborne Bull, unique symbol in the history of design and icon of Spain in the world.
