A leading expert in human rights, social justice, equity, diversity and inclusion my research program is comprised of several interrelated areas: Organizational Consultation, Social Justice Theory and Pedagogy, Feminist/Multicultural Counselling Psychology, and International Psychology. As well, I have a particular interest in sexual violence, gender based violence, homophobic bullying, and workplace challenges (e.g., harassment, bullying, and violence).
